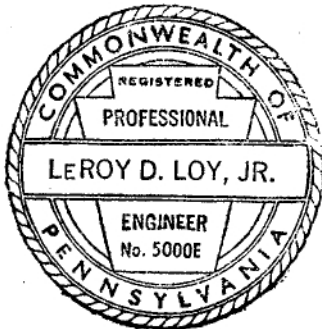
Dear Doctor Charnbury:
